Victory over Great and Terrible Enemies  
Isaiah 42:13; Isaiah 54:17; Isaiah 59:19

Praise the Lord. I welcome you to this special session tonight. I pray that the specialty in this session and the sacredness in the session...I pray it will be transferred and transmitted to your soul in Jesus' name. The victory that Jesus brought on Calvary: that victory will come to your life. You want to rise up now as a mighty army of the Lord, that tonight every foe and every enemy will be conquered in your life and family in Jesus' name.

Tonight we are going to have the victory, victory over the terrible enemies and the lions of the children of God. I want you to get ready and prepare yourself. Open your mouth and talk to the Lord in prayer - that tonight will be your night of victory, your night of deliverance, your night of dominion.

It is a follow up on what we learnt in the morning...Pull them down, all the strongholds in your life. Tonight we come to complete everything...victory, deliverance, dominion, authority and power. You will run; you will not grow weary. You will walk and you will not faint. This is the day of His power. This is the time and the period of victory for every child of God. Moving on, moving on, going on to victory. All enemies defeated. All adversaries overcome. The Lord will give you tonight the Spirit of the Conqueror, that no giant, no Philistine, no enemy will be able to stand before you.

Victory tonight. Victory tonight. Victory tonight. Tonight the Lord will finish what we began in the morning. Every form of weakness still remaining in you, every form of defeat still remaining in your life...tonight is the night of victory and deliverance and dominion. Conquering the giants, defeating the enemies, pulling down all those strongholds...tonight is that night. In Jesus' name we pray.

Say this with me: "Tonight I have total victory. Tonight everything still remaining will be destroyed. Tonight I have victory over all my enemies. I will conquer. I will overcome. I will rise up and move on with the Spirit of the Conqueror." In Jesus' name we pray.

Heavenly Father, we come tonight. We thank you because of the great work you started in the morning, pulling down the strongholds in every life, in every family, in every ministry, in every church. Lord, tonight we come to complete the defeat of the evil one. We pray that your victory, and your power, the anointing, the authority will flow into every life tonight in Jesus' name. Lord, I pray all those who are lying down in defeat, they will rise up in victory tonight in Jesus' name.

I pray, Lord, that those who have been running away from the enemy, they will stand and turn back and run toward the enemy and engage the enemy in combat and defeat the enemy tonight in

Jesus' name. I pray for the young, for the old, for the children, for the parents, for everybody in the church, that tonight will be the night of victory for everyone...victory in our business, victory in our personal lives, victory in our families, victory in the church, victory in the day and victory in the night. Confirm it, oh Lord, in Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

Thank you very much. We can sit down. Tonight we come to consider the message together with ministration. Understand what I said? *The message* that is one. *The ministration* that is two. Because something is going to be ministered to your life tonight. You hear the message. You receive the ministration. You will never be the same again in your life in Jesus' name.

*Victory over the Great, Terrible Enemies.* Noticed what I said? I didn't just say 3 enemies now. What you have on your program is *Victory over the Great Three Enemies*. But now I'm changing that word *three* and substituting the word *terrible*...because what if you have 4 enemies? What if you have 5? What if they are 7? What if they are 100? Not only 3. No matter the number tonight, you will bring every one of them down. *Victory over the Great, Terrible Enemies.*

Isaiah, chapter 42, verse 13: ***"The LORD shall go forth as a mighty man, he shall stir up jealousy like a man of war: he shall cry, yea, roar; he shall prevail against his enemies."*** Your enemies are God's enemies. Anybody standing against you is standing against God. All the enemies of God are going to be defeated in Jesus' name. Here it tells us that the Almighty God Himself, with great power, supernatural power, that He will go forth as a mighty man. He will stir up even the jealousy like a man of war. He will cry. Yes, He will roar. Then it says, ***"He shall prevail."*** He will prevail overall all His enemies. Tonight is the beginning of that victory in every life in Jesus' name.

Isaiah, chapter 54, verse 17: ***"No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me," saith the LORD.*** As you come to the Lord through Calvary and Jesus Christ, we have learnt over and over now - He died for us on the cross of Calvary. Because of that crucifixion, because of the shedding of His blood, we have redemption. We have reconciliation. We have righteousness. The riches of the kingdom belong to us.

Then it says, "Because your righteousness is of the Lord, no weapon that is fashioned against you shall ever prosper. Every tongue that rises up to speak against you, all of them, they will be conquered. They will fall to rise no more in Jesus' name.

Isaiah 59, verse 19: ***"So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood..."*** with real torrential force and with real great speed...wanting to swallow you up, wanting to sweep you away from your feet, wanting to destroy you and to defeat you. ***"When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him."*** And will drive him back from you in Jesus' name.

*Victory over the Great, Terrible Enemies.* I divide the message into 3 points tonight:

1. *Deliverance from the Terrifying Enemies.* The enemies that terrorize you, the enemies that terrify you, and the enemies that try to torment you...tonight is the night you are going to walk out in victory in Jesus' name. *Deliverance from the Terrifying Enemies.*
2. *Defeat of All Tormenting Enemies.* Do you know we're going to destroy them tonight? Do you know we'll march over them tonight? We'll conquer them in Jesus' name. *Defeat of All Tormenting Enemies.*
3. *Dominion over the Terrible Enemy.* Dominion over the terrible enemy.

We come to number 1 which is *Deliverance from the Terrifying Enemies.* We're looking at Exodus, chapter 23, and we're reading from verse 25. Notice every word because the word spells out your victory, your dominion...spells out that you're going to overcome without any shadow of doubt. Exodus, chapter 23, verse 25. It says, **"And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take..."** What? **"...sickness away from the midst of thee. There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfill."**

Now look at verse 27: **"I will send my fear before thee, and will destroy all the people to whom thou shalt come, and I will make all thine enemies turn their backs unto thee."** Give me a good *amen*. There the Lord said He will touch you and heal you if you're sick. There the Lord said He will fulfill the number of your days. Not only that; He said, all the enemies that shall rise up against you...the way they came, that's the way they will go back. He says He will turn them back away from you. It will be so in Jesus' name.

In 2 Chronicles, chapter 20, verse 27: **"Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat in the forefront of them, to go again to Jerusalem with joy."** You'll go back home with joy. As we finish this retreat tomorrow by the grace of God, your cup will be full and overflowing in Jesus' name. The joy of the Lord will be your strength in Jesus' name. Going back, you'll be celebrating. Going back, you'll be singing. The song of praise will never leave your mouth in Jesus' name.

It says they now went back again to Jerusalem with joy **"... for the LORD had made them to rejoice over..."** Who? **"...over their enemies."** What the Lord did for them, the Lord will do for you. When the battles started, Jehoshaphat was so much afraid, and he said, "Oh Lord, we don't know what we're going to do." By the time everything ended, here we are told he rejoiced over his enemies. All those terrifying enemies, that you have been shaking the knees and shaking the mind and trembling before them, because they were terrorizing you, at the end of the meeting tonight, you're going to rejoice over those enemies.

**"And they came to Jerusalem with psalteries and harps and trumpets unto the house of the LORD. And the fear of God was on all the kingdoms of those countries, when they had heard that the LORD fought against the enemies of Israel."** The Lord fought against the enemies of His people. God has not changed. He says, "I am God. I change not." **"Jesus Christ, the same yesterday and today and forever."** As the Almighty God fought against the enemies of Jehoshaphat and Judah, the Almighty God will fight against your enemies in Jesus' name.

***"So the realm of Jehoshaphat was quiet: for his God gave him rest round about."*** You are going to have peace. You will have rest. All the hurrying up and down, running to and fro, wanting to hide (and seek and hide)...you've been hiding away from those people terrorizing your life. All that running away and running around...all that is gone. I said, "All that is gone." You will stand your ground, and it is the enemies that will run in Jesus' name.

Psalm 18...reading from verse 17: ***"He delivered me from my strong enemy..."*** He'll do it for you. ***"...and from them which hated me: for they were too strong for me."*** It means then no matter the strength or the power of those enemies that were trying to kind of wipe you out of the earth, tonight the Lord is saying He will deliver you from those strong enemies. Even though they have been too strong for you, they're not too strong for the Lord. I said, "They're not too strong for the Lord."

***"They prevented me in the day of my calamity: but the LORD was my stay. He brought me forth also into a large place; he delivered me, because he delighted in me. The LORD rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands hath he recompensed me. For I have kept the ways of the LORD, and have not wickedly departed from my God. For all his judgments were before me, and I did not put away his statutes from me. I was also upright before him, and I kept myself from mine iniquity. Therefore hath the LORD recompensed me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands in his eyesight."*** That righteousness the Lord has given you will attract victory into your life in Jesus' name.

Psalm 27...I'm reading from verse 1, ***"The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?"*** Think about your life. Who are the people that make you afraid? What do they do that makes you afraid? How do they look...their faces? What's their stature...making you afraid? But tonight the Lord is your strength and the Lord is your light and the Lord is your salvation. Whom will you fear? ***"The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell."*** They stumbled and they fell.

After this day anybody trying to run after you to destroy your life, they will stumble and they will fall. ***"Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident."*** The confidence of the Lord will come to your life tonight in Jesus' name. The victory that Jesus Christ purchased on the cross of Calvary when He gave a spiritual knockout, knock-down, knock-up against the devil...that victory will be yours tonight in Jesus' name.

Psalm 112, I'm reading from verse 6: ***"Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance. He shall not be afraid of evil tidings [bad news]..."*** ***"...his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD. His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon..."*** Who? ***"...upon his enemies."*** That's why the Lord is telling you tonight there is deliverance waiting for every one of us in Jesus' name.

Jeremiah, chapter 31, verse 11, ***"For the LORD hath redeemed Jacob..."*** Put your name there. I said, "You should put your name there." For the Lord has redeemed who? For the Lord has redeemed...that's you. He has redeemed you. ***"... and ransomed him from the hand of him that was stronger than he."*** He has redeemed us. He has ransomed us from the hands of the people that are stronger than we are. You know why we used to fear them? Because we felt, "They're stronger than me. He's bolder than I am. He's mightier than I am. If he confronts me, he'll knock me down."

But nobody will knock you down again because Jesus Christ, your Lord, your Master, your King, your Savior...He knocked him down on the cross of Calvary. Since that time, he has not recovered. He will never recover. Your enemies are knocked down. Then it says, "The Lord has redeemed you and ransomed you from the hand of him that was stronger than you are."

We're looking at Luke, chapter 1. He's going to redeem you from all your enemies so you have the freedom to live in righteousness and holiness before Him all the days of your life. Luke, chapter 1, verse 70: ***"As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began: That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us."***

That's why we don't worry anymore. That's why we're not telling stories anymore. Do you know they hate me? It doesn't matter anymore. All those people that hate you, they will never hinder your progress in Jesus' name because we should be saved, delivered, set free from our enemies ***"...and from the hand of all who hate us; To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant; The oath which he swore to our father Abraham, That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him..."*** How? ***"...without fear, In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life."*** He will deliver you. He has delivered in the past. He is delivering now. He'll keep on delivering you until the end of your life in Jesus' name.

2 Timothy, chapter 4, verse 18: ***"And the Lord shall deliver me..."*** And the Lord shall deliver me - from what? From some evil works? From the majority of those evil works? From what? ***"...from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen."***

2. *The Defeat of All Tormenting Enemies.* I'm asking you a question now. Did anybody ever torture you? Did anybody ever torment you? You felt the pain, the heat of their torment. Every time you remember and you see somebody that looks like that man that tormented you, that woman that tormented you when you were young, then the fear would come again. Tonight all that fear is banished out of your life, out of your heart in Jesus' name.

Exodus, chapter 23, verse 22: the defeat of all those terrifying, tormenting, terrorizing enemies. ***"But if thou shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies."*** If your enemy has the Almighty God as his enemy, then that enemy's finished. The One that opened the Red Sea becomes an enemy to your enemy. That enemy is finished. The One that made the Jericho walls to fall flat as a result of the shouting of the people of God...that

same Almighty God with almighty power becomes the enemy of your enemies. Those enemies, they are finished in Jesus' name.

The One that conquered Goliath and the One that conquered all those Philistines and the One that conquered the enemies of Jehoshaphat...the One that sent the horses of fire and the chariots of fire for Elisha to protect him...that same God, that same Creator God, that same Almighty God becomes the enemy of your enemies. I say tonight, all those your enemies, they are finished in Jesus' name.

After tonight, when you're walking back to the hostel or anywhere you are going, you walk and stand up properly. You square your shoulders. You lift up your eyes. You walk like the child of the king. You walk like somebody that is owning the world with the Almighty God because nobody can stop you now...your progress. No enemy can hinder you anymore in Jesus' name.

From tonight, and then tomorrow when you're going back home, you will not be walking...and then your back is bent and then you're looking down as if you're afraid to look on the faces of people. You'll straighten up and your chest out like a militant soldier. You look at everybody eyeball to eyeball and say, "I'm the child of the King. I am the child of the King. I am the child of the King."

The places you were afraid to go before...after tomorrow, go back there. The places you were running away from before...after tomorrow, go back there. How about the enemies that were waiting for you? If you know where they are, go back there. When you show up, you'll say, "He's coming." Fire will come out of your eyeballs. Power and authority will come out of your mouth. When you stand and you declare anything, it shall be done in Jesus' name. Because an army of God's militant people...they're leaving this place tomorrow and we're going back to where we came from. Every hill will be leveled before you in Jesus' name.

All those giants and the sons of Anakim that tried to make the children of Israel go back and they could not get to the land of Canaan...they will not stop you. I said, "They will not stop you." The people that put any curse upon your life...tonight I remove that curse in Jesus' name. Because it says in verse 22, ***"But if thou shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries."***

Leviticus, chapter 26, I'm reading to you there from verse 3: ***"If ye walk in my statutes, and keep my commandments, and do them; Then I will give you rain in due season, and the land shall yield her increase, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit. And your threshing shall reach unto the vintage, and the vintage shall reach unto the sowing time: and ye shall eat your bread to the full."*** I thought you'd say *amen*.

Economic meltdown will not catch you. There will be no famine in your home. There'll be no famine in your business. There'll be no famine in your family. Then it says, "You will dwell in your land safely." ***"And I will give peace in the land, and ye shall lie down, and none shall make you afraid: and I will rid evil beasts out of the land, neither shall the sword go through your land..."*** anymore. ***"And ye shall chase your enemies..."*** Ye shall chase your enemies. ***"...and they shall fall before you by the sword. And five of you shall chase an hundred, and***

*an hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight: and your enemies shall fall before you by the sword."*

We're looking at Deuteronomy, chapter 33. I'm reading from verse 27, *"The eternal God is thy refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms: and he shall thrust out the enemy from before thee; and shall say, 'Destroy them.'"* Verse 29: *"Happy art thou, O Israel: who is like unto thee, O people saved by the LORD, the shield of thy help, and who is the sword of thy excellency! and thine enemies shall be found liars unto thee; and thou shalt tread upon their high places."*

Psalms 89.... Your enemies are defeated already. That *amen* will defeat your enemies. When you go back home, you go back in confidence, rejoicing that the promises of God are *yes* and *amen* in your life in Jesus' name. Psalm 89, verse 22: *"The enemy shall not exact upon him; nor the son of wickedness afflict him."* They will not be able to afflict you anymore. All those things that came to crawl on your back or crawl on your body, all those serpentine spirits trying to destroy you, and trying to delay the miracle power of God in your life, they're destroyed tonight. *"And I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague them that hate him. And my faithfulness and my mercy shall be with him: and in my name shall his horn be exalted."*

Jeremiah, chapter 20...we're looking at Jeremiah now. Jeremiah, chapter 20...we're looking at verse 11: *"But the LORD is with me..."* I said, "The Lord is with me." *"...as a mighty terrible one: therefore my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly ashamed; for they shall not prosper: their everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten."* You stand upon those promises, and those promises will be *yes* and *amen* in your life in Jesus' name.

Micah, chapter 7, verse 8...very near the end of the Old Testament. *"Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise."* Maybe the enemies have seen that you fell into poverty and they were rejoicing, "Ah ha. Catch him. God has caught him." Well, all that joy of the enemy will come to an end in Jesus' name. Maybe they see that you fall into sickness, into calamity, into poverty, into joblessness, into some difficulty...you are telling them tonight, "Stop the rejoicing." *"Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the LORD shall be a light unto me."* Your light will come tonight in Jesus' name.

Then look at verse 10, *"Then she that is mine enemy shall see it, and shame shall cover her which said unto me, 'Where is the LORD thy God?'"* If they have been asking you the question, *Where is your God? Where is your God?* They will see that God in your life tonight, and they will come to shame in Jesus' name. *"Mine eyes shall behold her: now shall she [the enemy] be trodden down as the mire of the streets."*

Zephaniah, chapter 3, and I am reading from verse 15, *"The LORD hath taken away thy judgments, he hath cast out thine enemy: the king of Israel, even the LORD, is in the midst of thee: thou shalt not see evil any more."* What have you seen in the past? What calamity have you beheld in the past? What evil has visited you in the past? Thou shalt see evil no more in your life in Jesus' name. *"In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem, Fear thou not: and to Zion, Let not thine hands be slack. The LORD thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save..."*

thee. He will save thee. **"... he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing."** I said, "With singing." You will rejoice and you will sing in Jesus' name.

3. *Dominion over the Terrible Enemy.* That is the chief of them, the highest of them, the greatest of them - Dominion over the terrible enemy.

1 Peter, chapter 5, I'm reading from verse 8. Tonight you have that dominion. **"Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: Whom resist stedfast in the faith."** Don't allow him, don't give in, don't give up...resist him steadfast in the faith. **"...knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world."** If you resist the devil, he will flee away from you. I said, "He will flee away from you."

James, chapter 4, verse 7: **"Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist..."** Who? **"...the devil..."** What will he do? Again? Do you know some people that say the devil is always after them? And no matter how they fast and pray, the devil never leaves them. Maybe you are not joining faith with your fasting. Maybe you're not joining faith with your prayer...because it says, "Resist him steadfast *in the faith*, and then he will flee from you." Tonight, he will flee away from you. After all, he's a defeated foe. After all, he has been knocked down, a deadly blow in the head.

Hebrews, chapter 2, verse 14: **"Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil."** He will destroy him away from your life, away from your family. Calvary, the crucifixion of Christ will accomplish that in your life, and in your family in Jesus' name. **"And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage."** No bondage anymore in your life.

1 John, chapter 4, verse 4. Always remember this. **"Ye are of God, little children..."** I am of God. I am of God. I'm a child of God. I have overcome them. **"...because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world."** He will not touch you anymore. He will not touch your family anymore. He will not touch your children anymore.

Look at chapter 5...1 John, chapter 5, verse 18: **"We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not."** What does the Bible say? That wicked one toucheth him not. Instead of *him*, you are going to put *me*. That wicked one toucheth me not. Say everything now. You are protected. He will preserve your life. I'm telling you, if you have been crying, wipe away your tears because the day of joy has come in your life in Jesus' name.

Jeremiah, chapter 15 (you will love this)...reading from verse 20 and verse 21. **"'And I will make thee unto this people a fenced brasen wall: and they shall fight against thee, but they shall not prevail against thee: for I am with thee to save thee and to deliver thee,' saith the LORD. 'And I will deliver thee out of the hand of the wicked.'"** I will redeem you out of the hand of the wicked. I will redeem you out of the hand of the terrible. He will deliver you from

Mr. Terrible. He will not allow Mr. Terror to ever take any hold in your life in Jesus' name. In the day and in the night, the Almighty God will be watching over you and will preserve you from terror and will preserve from the terrible in Jesus' name.

Now our favorite Psalm...Psalm 91...I'm reading from verse 11, *"...he shall give his angels charge over me..."* He shall give his angels charge over me. *"...to keep me in all my ways. They shall bear me up in their hands, lest I dash my foot against a stone. I will tread upon the lion and adder..."* I will tread upon the lion and the adder. I will tread upon the lion and the adder. *"...the young lion and the dragon shall I trample under feet."* Is that you? I said, "Is that you?" I welcome you to that victory tonight in Jesus' name.

In Luke, chapter 10, I'm reading from verse 19: *"Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy..."* And from tonight, nothing...nothing...nothing. *"...nothing shall by any means hurt you."* Do you have the victory already? I said, "Do you have victory already?" Do you see some soldiers they say they have victory and they're sitting down? Do you see those soldiers like that? The army of the Lord...victory, dominion, deliverance, miracle, power, authority...and the Lord said He has given you that power and that authority. Nothing shall by any means hurt you again in Jesus' name.

While you stand like a militant soldier, while you stand like a triumphant soldier, you raise your voice now in confidence to the Lord. You know all your enemies are defeated tonight. You stand in that victory of the Lord, and nothing will turn you back anymore in your life.

Whatever the number of enemies, yours is the victory tonight. Yours is the dominion tonight. Nothing will be able to stand before you. Freedom has come. Liberty has come. The freedom to live as God wants you to live. The liberty to live in the joy of the Lord. The Lord is by your side as the mighty, terrible One.

You will walk, you will not faint. You will run, you will not be weary. You will make progress. Keep on moving on. Keep on moving on. Keep on moving on in the strength, in the power of the Lord. Dominion...that's yours. Victory...that is yours. The overcoming life...that is yours. The victorious life...that is yours. The triumphant life...that is yours.

This is the moment of victory. Don't play with it. This is the moment of dominion. Don't play with it. Satan should not defeat you anymore. Evil spirits should not defeat you anymore. Temptation and sin should not defeat you anymore. There is the Spirit of the Conqueror inside you. You can live in that Spirit of the Conqueror from tonight.

Victory - victory over the great, terrible enemies. Victory, dominion, power, authority: no more fear, no more trembling, no more shaking. *"Greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world."* The greater One indwells you. The greater One abides in you. You fear no foe. You fear no enemy. *"No weapon that is formed against you shall prosper. Every tongue that shall rise up against you in judgment, thou shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord. Their righteousness is of me," says the Lord."*

No shame, no sorrow, no fear, no timidity. Victory, dominion, power, authority. Keep on moving on. Keep on moving on. Keep on moving on until you get into that success, that victory, that triumph and live the overcoming life. You don't need to run helter-skelter. Your victory is right there. You are an overcomer. You are an overcomer. You are the triumphant one, the victorious one.

The Lord is on your side. Jesus is on your side. He died for you. He broke the head of the devil on your behalf. He defeated the enemy on your behalf. The Almighty God is an enemy to your enemy. He will deliver you from the hands of all the people that hate you. Nothing will never make you afraid anymore. Nothing will intimidate you anymore. Victory, dominion, triumph...that's yours today.

The greater One lives inside you. The mightier One lives on the inside of you. The Almighty, the One that has all power in heaven and on earth...He lives on the inside of you. You can go through life hand in hand with the Almighty and nothing will ever defeat you anymore. Go through life with confidence. Go through life in partnership with the Lord Jesus Christ...a greater one that lives inside you.

The way will clear before you. The road will be plain before you. The wilderness will blossom before you. There shall be showers of blessing. No desert, no famine, no scarcity, no poverty anymore. Your prayers are answered. Your needs are met. Your desires are fulfilled. Your longings are answered.

Good news. Good news. Good news...no defeat anymore. Good news...dominion, triumph, and victory. Good news...miracle children. Good news...marriage, the way is open. Good news...prosperity and employment. Good news...your enemies will lick the dust. Good news...you'll be standing firm rejoicing and singing the song of praises unto the Lord. Good news, good news, good news for you from today. In Jesus' name we pray.

Victorious people of God...triumphant people of God...and people that will never be defeated...people of God that have dominion today - in Jesus' name we pray. One of you will chase a thousand. Ten of you will put a hundred thousand to flight in Jesus' name. Where you were defeated before, you will not be defeated anymore. Victory and dominion will come upon your life in Jesus' name. Your tears are wiped away. Your sorrow is taken away. Your sterility, barrenness is taken away. The power of the enemy is broken in your life in Jesus' name.

You are not poor anymore, you are rich. You are not weak anymore, you are strong. You are not sick anymore, you are well. You are not defeated anymore, you are victorious. Raise up those blessed, anointed hands. I'm telling you, after this retreat, that every enemy will bow before you in Jesus' name...in Jesus' name. Do you have the victory? I said, "Do you have the victory?"

Father, in the name of Jesus, we thank You tonight for all Your promises which are *yes* and *amen*. We stand upon those promises tonight. We pray for every child of God, every brother, every sister, every participant at this retreat, from the youngest to the oldest...we pray, oh Lord, Your victory will come into every life in Jesus' name. The spirit that conquers...that conquers

sin, that conquers sickness, that conquers Satan, that conquers infirmity, that conquers idolatry, that conquers iniquity...that spirit that conquers will come to every life tonight in Jesus' name.

When David was a little boy, he confronted Goliath, and he brought him down. I pray, Lord, tonight, every Goliath before the children of God will come down in Jesus' name. Protect your people, shield your people, preserve your people. I pray that your power will never lack in the lives of your people in Jesus' name. I ask, oh Lord, from tonight, your people will go from strength to strength, from glory to glory, from power to power, and from one level of victory to another level of victory in Jesus' name.

I pray, Lord, those who have fallen before, they will rise up today. Those who were timid and fearful before, they'll be bold tonight in Jesus' name. As we go back home, oh Lord, we are going back home to victory, to triumph, to dominion. We pray that every evil thing that has prevailed upon your people before... You destroy them tonight in Jesus' name. I pray that the victory that has started today...that victory will never end. That victory will never end. That victory will never end. Confirm it in every life from tonight, oh Lord, in Jesus' name we pray. And everybody said...and everybody shouted...Amen. You have the victory in Jesus' name.
